## ATHLETE DECLARATIONS

Reminder that all athletes wishing to be considered for the 2024 BC/Yukon Command Legion U18 and 15YO Team must submit an athlete declaration to be considered for the team.

## BC/YUKON ENTRIES

BC Athletics will complete all entries for athletes selected as part of the BC/Yukon Command Legion team. Athletes, coaches and parents are pleased asked to familiarize themselves with athlete entry restrictions for the Legion Championships. ## ACCOMMODATIONS

**Athletes selected to the BC/Yukon Team must stay with team accommodations.** Athletes must also stay with team accommodations throughout the entirety of the Legion Camp August 7-13, 2024.

Accommodations for all teams will be onsite at the University of Calgary. Bed linen and towel will be provided. The remainder of the necessary toiletries including facecloth, soap, shampoo etc. is the responsibility of the individual athlete.

There is no air conditioning in any of the residence buildings, so it is recommended that athletes pack a small fan if possible.

## TRAVEL

**Athletes selected to the BC/Yukon Team must travel with the legion team on the legion team flight reservation.** See below for BC/Yukon Command Legion Team:

## **BC TEAM + LEGION TEAM FEES**

There are 2 fees to be paid by selected athletes. They are as follows:

1. BC Team Fees (see below)
2. BC/Yukon Legion Team Fees (approx. \$200-\$250)

Selected athletes will be asked to fill out a team acknowledgement form once selected. Athletes will be able to indicate who will pay these fees (club or athlete). Please speak with you club prior to filling out the acknowledgement form to confirm the payee.
