ATHLETICS FOR ALL GRANT

BC Athletics is a recent recipient of the Athletics Canada "Athletics for All Grant", funded by the Government of Canada. We will use these funds to enhance our community Run Jump Throw Wheel programs, with a focus on inviting newcomers to Canada to get involved with Athletics throughout the province. As part of this grant, we recently hosted a "FREE" Run Jump Throw Wheel Instructor course, where we had more than 35 participants register to be trained in facilitating Run Jump Throw Wheel programs in their clubs, communities, and schools.

Additionally, we have received grant funding for Athletics in Canada Day, funded by the Government of Canada. This event will promote and celebrate Athletics in Canada. We will host activations on June 12, 2024 in Victoria, as part of the Victoria Track Classic and June 15 in Burnaby, as part of the Harry Jerome Track Classic.
